**SUBJECT:** Monthly Report April 2011

Crews responded on a total of 289 responses during the month of April. This is compared to 306 calls in April of 2010. Our year to date emergencies for 2011 are 1180 compared to 1187 in 2010. Of those incidents, there were 241 medic-related incidents and 48 fire-related incidents. In addition to regular fire related responses, the engine was sent out on 62 medical assist emergencies.

We provided 16 mutual aid medics to surrounding communities for the month, and received two mutual aid medics. We received nine fire mutual aid responses and provided one fire engine for the month.

Our Car Seat Technician had one request to install car seats this month.

Our April emergency medical training was a review of incident documentation. The fire training we conducted covered was basement operations, and we utilized one of the city owned houses on Huberville Avenue. All Fire Department personnel participated in a Drug Free Workplace Training conducted by Ron Wean of Employee Care, and Battalion Chief David Stitzel.

Firefighter/paramedic Ed Kronenberger attended the Weapons of Mass Destruction Radiological / Nuclear Materials Technicians Course. He also took the train the trainer course for WMD Radiological / Nuclear Awareness. These courses were conducted at the Nevada Test Site and provided at no cost to the City of Riverside by FEMA.

Overtime for the month of April was 4.50 hours.
