SUBJECT: Monthly Report March 2011

Crews responded on a total of 273 responses during the month of March. This is compared to 305 calls in March of 2010. Our year to date emergencies for 2011 are 891 compared to 881 in 2010. Of those incidents, there were 242 medic-related incidents and 31 fire-related incidents. In addition to regular fire related responses, the engine was sent out on 65 medical assist emergencies.

We provided 25 mutual aid medics for the month. We received 3 medics for the month. We received 3 fire mutual aid responses and provided 0 fire engines for the month.

Our Car Seat Technician had one request to install car seats this month.

Outreach- Firefighter Peters and Wenzler conducted a fire safety talk to a group of preschool kids at Virginia Stevens Head start program. Firefighter Balcom gave an educational talk to a group of kids at Stebbins High School.

Our March emergency medical training was our annual protocol test and final skill check-offs. . The fire training we conducted covered search and rescue evolutions in a smoke filled environment. We utilized a city owned house on Huberville.

Overtime for the month of March was 59.75 hours.
