

**City of Riverside

The first reading of Ordinance 10-O-450 was approved on May 6, 2010. Copies of this ordinance are available to the public without cost at the City of Riverside Municipal Building located at 1791 Harshman Rd., Riverside, Ohio 45424 during normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The second reading of the ordinance will be May 20, 2010 at the City of Riverside Municipal Building at 7:30 p.m. Following the second reading, the City Council will also consider adoption of this ordinance.

The proposed ordinance is as follows:

Ordinance No. 10-O-450

ORDINANCE 10-O-450 AMENDING ORDINANCE 08-O-401 TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF COUNCIL APPOINTED MEMBERS OF THE MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FROM FIVE TO SEVEN.

WHEREAS, Council has previously enacted Ordinance 08-O-401, which established a Multimodal Transportation Commission for the City of Riverside, Ohio, to facilitate certain infrastructural improvements in a manner that contributes to the safety, health, and economic well-being of, and is desirable for the efficient operation of, the City of Riverside; and

WHEREAS, the Multimodal Transportation Commission is recommending to Council an amendment to Ordinance 08-O-401 which would increase the Commission's Council-Appointed membership from five members to seven members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section I: That Section I of Ordinance 08-O-401 is hereby amended to read as follows, with the inserted language appearing in underlined type:

“That there is hereby created a Multimodal Transportation Commission for the City. The Commission shall consist of seven members to be appointed by Council in its sole discretion. Membership shall be open to any resident elector of the City, one of which will be a local business representative. In addition, the Director of Transportation of Mad River Local Schools, a representative from RTA, a representative from Metro

Parks, and one current member of City Council shall be considered “*Ex officio*” members. The term of service for each Commission member shall be three years; provided, however, that of the first seven Commission members appointed by Council, four shall be appointed to a term of three years and three shall be appointed to a term of two years. Any member who misses three consecutive meetings without being excused by a majority of the Commission may be declared inactive by Council and replaced as provided above.”

Section II: That Ordinance 08-O-401 shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

Section III: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date permitted by law.
